Core indicator 1.1 :

AmplifyChange grantees needing capacity building support developed, implemented and achieved organisational capacity-building plans

At least 70% of AmplifyChange grantees who need capacity building support have started strengthening capacity according to plans

At least 50% of AmplifyChange grantees who need capacity building support have started developing organisational capacity-building plans

Core indicator 1.2 :

Lessons learnt gathered, disseminated and used by AmplifyChange grantees

At least 20% of grantees undertaking rigorous advocacy planning (for example, policy mapping, audience analysis)

Exceeded 31%

Core indicator 2.2 :

Increased participation of civil society groups in policy and budgetary processes

January 2018

Increased participation in policy and budgetary processes in at least 30% of AmplifyChange grantees

Off-track 17%

January 2017

Increased participation in policy and budgetary processes in at least 10% of AmplifyChange grantees

Indicators

Core indicator 2.3:

National policies, laws, budget allocations improved by civil society engagement (including the introduction of new and/or improved policies, or the mitigation of negative policies, all to create a more favourable policy environment for SRHR)

At least 10% of AmplifyChange grantees have increased public support or reduced negative statements from key influencers

January 2017

At least 20% of grantees involved in working with key influencers to effect their public support for SRHR

At least 20% of AmplifyChange grantees have increased engagement amongst service providers to actively support SRHR for all populations, including vulnerable and marginalised

Progress rating and Means of verification



Definition of progress rating
