



Opportunity

Micro grant to help smaller community-based groups pursue new approaches and ideas for advocacy at local level

To support new CSOs to embark on engaging in SRHR advocacy

Up to EUR40,000, there is no lower limit

No minimum duration, maximum duration up to 1 year

In 2016, available during specified grant calls focusing on themes (FGM/CEFM and abortion) Initially called 'innovation' grants



Strengthening

Small grant to support small and medium-sized groups to implement projects that pursue specific change

To support a wide range of advocacy and policy engagement activities

Between EUR40,000 to EUR100,000

Minimum duration is 6 months, maximum is 2 years

Available during specified grant call windows



Network

Significant support to networks and coalitions

Four key areas for action:
- Capacity building
- Evidence building
- Communications
- Coalition building

Between EUR150,000 to EUR550,000 over 2 years

Maximum duration up to 2 years

Available during specified grant call windows



Strategic

Significant support to organisations who are working internationally across the Sub-Saharan Africa and South Asia regions

To support scale-up of advocacy or innovation to inform global and regional policy/strategy and strengthen connections with national movements

Up to EUR1.2million per annum over three years (replenishment annually based on results)

Maximum duration up to 3 years

Available during specified grant call windows
